Haj Seminar

A comprehensive full day Haj Seminar will be organised in the north, either in Huddersfield or Manchester. It is part of your agreement to attend this important day when you book your Haj with us.

Non Shifting

30 June & 2 July Depart from London & Manchester to Jeddah.

After arrival procedure, in Jeddah airport, transfer to Makkah on Mutawwif supplied coaches.

Arrive in Makkah and check in Rawdah Khalil. Perform Umrah. Tamattu

Change Ihram into normal clothings. Free days in Makkah and Ziarat trip, if permitted by Saudi authority.

7 Z Hajja. After Asar, Change into Ihram and make Niyyah for Haj.

After dinner stay in room and await transfer to Mina.

Take up pre allocated space in Mina camp. Explore the camp and its surroundings to be acquainted with the environment.

8 Z Hajja. Spend the day in the camp.

9 Z Hajja. On the morning of 9 Zul Hajja be ready to be transferred to Arafah. This is The Day of Haj.

Spend the early part of morning in rest or zikr. After lunch spend the remaining day in intense worship.

After Maghreb time, prepare to be transferred to the open grounds of Muzdalifa.

Combine Maghreb and Eisha Salah singly or in congregation with the group.

Collect 72 pebbles for Rami Jamarat.

10 Z Hajja. After Fajar salah get ready to be transferred to Mina camp. After arrival in Mina await advise by group leaders on walking to Jamarat to perform the Rami of 1st Jamarat and return back to camp or for transfer to Hotel and Haram to complete the Manasek of Haj., ie, Tawaf and Sai Ziarah, cutting hair, Qurbani and change back to normal clothings. Return back to hotel and await transfer to Mina.

11 Z Hajja. Perform Rami Jamaraat with group and return back to camp.

12 Z Hajja. Perform Rami Jamaraat with group. Proceed to Makkah with group. Your Haj is completed.

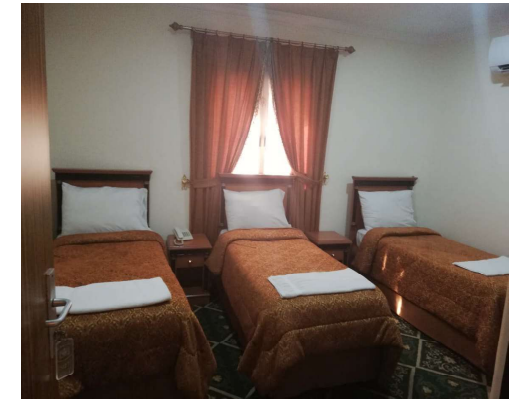
13 Z Hajja. Perform Tawaf ul Wida.

14 Z Hajja. Transfer to Madina in Private VIP Coaches.

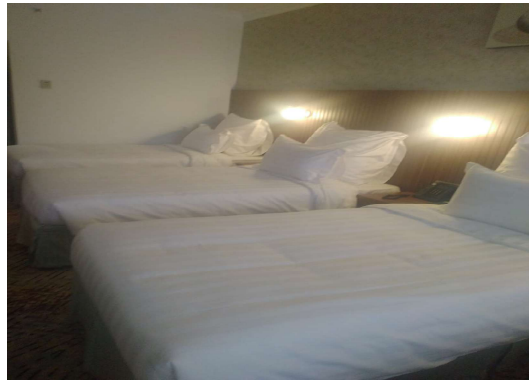
16 Z Hajja. Short tour ends with return back to UK.

14 to 17 Z Hajja. Free days in Madina and Zirat trip.

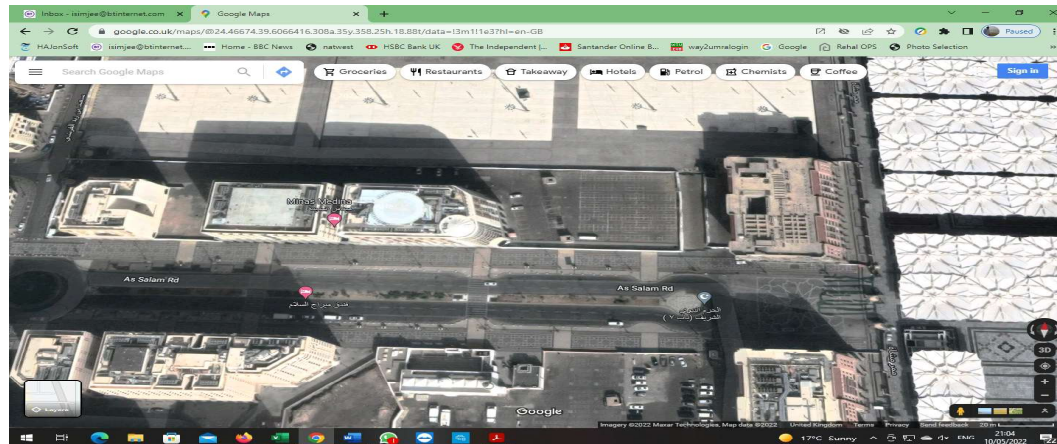
18 Z Hajja. Return back to UK.

CRUCIAL PARTS OF OUR TERMS AND CONDITIONS.

Please read and agree with our General Terms and Conditions available on our website,

Over 65 are not allowed to perform Haj this year.

You must be under that age limit when you make your booking with us.

Qurbani is not included in your package.

We will carryout your Qurbani upon your request and payment. We cannot guarantee that qurbani will be done on 10 Z Hajj following your Rami Jamaraat or Tawaf and Sai Ziarat. Under Hanafi Manasek, you will have to remain in the state of Ihram until your qurbani is done.

Full payment is required at the time of booking your Haj with us as we have no time to allow you just a deposit.

PCR TEST is not included in your package.

You will have to arrange this test not more then 72 hours before boarding your flight.

If your PCR Test is Positive then you cannot travel for Haj. You will forfeit your payment under that case and the only possible refund may be the airline tax component from your fare.

Travel Insurance. We strongly recommend you take a travel insurance for your own safety in the event that you may test Positive in PCR and lose your money as a consequence and to cover other factors such as inability to travel being ill or change in domestic circumstances, missing flight or losing baggage or travel document etc.

FACE MASK. This is a mandatory requirement by the Saudi government. You must wear a face mask at all time when out of your own hotel room and are in public domain. Please ensure you have sufficient supply of face mask on you when ready to travel. You will have to buy these at your own expense.

Entry into Haram. This is subject to control by the Presidency of Harmain Sharifains and through booking of umra and Tawaf slots through Eatamarana App on your android or smart phones that you must download. Your UK Sim will suffice, however, you are better off having a separate Saudi Sim.

Haj Seminar. It is part of our T&C that you attend the seminar which is for a full day period designed to provide you crucial advise and information about your Haj Journey and the experience you will have.

Religious Following and Guidance. We follow Ahl Sunnah wa Jamaa't and subscribe to Hanafi School of thought. Our Scholars will be advising you, upon request, or in their khutbas all aspects of Haj on Hanafi School of thoughts. However, we and our scholars accept and respect your own Aqeeda and the way you may choose to apply the statutory manaseks of the school you follow and will also guide you accordingly.

Segregation especially in the camps. We promote privacy of our sisters and the right ththey have for such privacy from non-mehrims. Mina camps are segregated as will be the camp in Arafah. Males and females are restricted from entering each other's tents under any circumstances. We advise use of handsets for communications between family segregated in the camps.
